***Consent for Audio Recording***

You are being asked to provide consent to being audio recorded during your focus group or interview.

Audio-recording helps researchers be sure that your ideas, opinions, and experiences are recorded accurately in the data collection process. Being recorded is voluntary. You can participate in an interview or focus group even if you do not consent to audio recording.

If you choose not to consent to being audio recorded, we will take notes during and after the session instead. Your decision will not have an impact on your employment with the Autism CanTech! Program or Research Project.

These recordings will be kept confidential. They will be filed by number only and stored in a secure folder on the NorQuest College server. They will be kept for 5 years on a NorQuest server under password protection.

- I understand that being audio recorded is voluntary and that I am free to withdraw my consent at any time by requesting that the taping be stopped.
- I understand that the destruction of the audio recording will be completed after 5 years. The recording will only be used for transcription and verification. It will be under password protection.
- I understand that confidentiality will be respected and that the audio tape will be for research use only.
- I consent to the audio recording of my interview or focus group.
